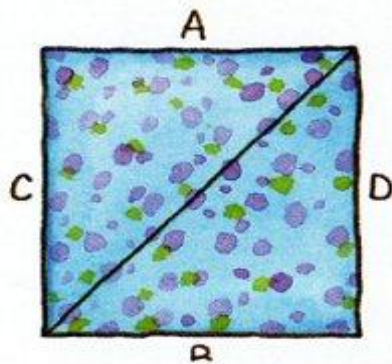
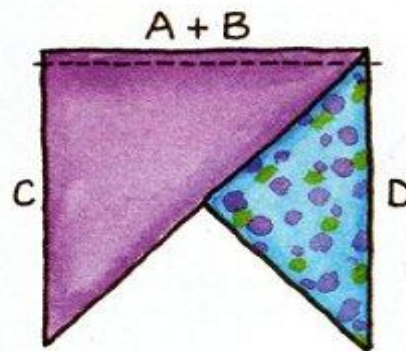


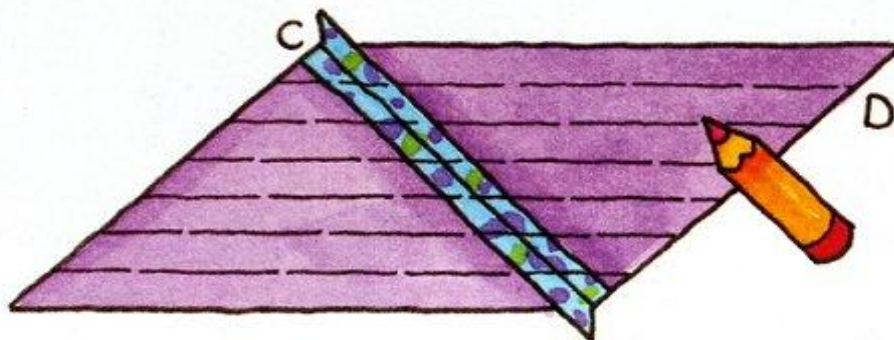
How to make a Lo-o-o-ong Continuous Bias Strip



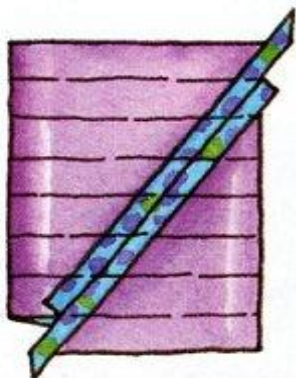
Cut a square, exactly on the straight grain of the fabric. Draw a line diagonally across. Cut on the line.



Sew 2 sides on straight grain together. Press seam open and flat.



Draw lines equal distance apart from left to right. This is the width of your final bias strips.



Sew raw edges together to form a tube - stepping lines one down. Match C to D. Press seam open.



Start cutting on line at one end of tube, in a spiral to release bias strip.
